SUBJECT: BYLAW TO FUND PARKS & RECREATION 1996 CAPITAL PROJECTS

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. THAT the Commission approve the expenditure of \$732,000 for eight projects as outlined in this report.
- 2. THAT Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$732,000 from Capital Reserves to finance the eight projects.

REPORT

The 1996 Capital Budget for Parks & Recreation contains the following eight projects to be funded from Capital Reserves:-

1. Bonsor telephone system upgrading.

\$55,500

To upgrade the telephone system to improve customer service and address safety and security issues.

2. Burnaby Lake Arena/Sports Complex

\$132,000

a) Arena Board Replacement

\$110,000

Completion of the Board replacement program at Burnaby Lake Arena.

b) C.G. Brown Telephone upgrade

22,000

Upgrade the telphone system to improve customer service and address safety and security issues.

3. Burnaby Village Museum

\$62,000

- a) Whitechurch Hardware Display \$12,000 Continued renovations and restoration of the building.
- b) Love House

50,000

Sprinkler installations and restorations

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BYLAW TO FUND PARKS & RECREATION 1996 CAPITAL PROJECTS

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4. Confederation Park

\$25,500

a) Skateboard Facility

\$20,000

For construction of the youth skateboard facility. Total cost is \$120,000. A bylaw for the first \$100,000 is already in place.

b) Lawn Bowling Improvements

\$5,500

Improvements requested by the Lawn Bowling Club in Confederation Park in order to accommodate the adjacent skateboard facility.

5. Deer Lake

\$137,000

- a) Century Gardens Landscaping Upgrade \$75,000 Upgrade of the pond and landscape in the vicinity of the Art Gallery, and the Shadbolt Centre.
- b) Upgrade lighting and pathway

\$37,000

Increased pedestrian traffic between the Art Gallery and Shadbolt Centre, necessitates upgrading of the pathways and lighting between the two facilities.

c) Trail Environmental Assessment of S.E. \$25,000 Trail

Environmental assessement and environmental design guidelines for a trail on the south east end of Deer Lake.

6. Hilda Park - Play Equipment.

\$35,000

The old playground equipment will be replaced with preschool and junior play equipment.

7. Kensington Park construct new sportsfield.

\$250,000

Construction of a new sportsfield adjacent to the pitch & putt.

8. Kisbey Park play equipment.

\$35,000

The old playground equipment will be replaced with preschool and junior play equipment.
