**REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL**

The Executive Committee of Council submits the following majority recommendation for Council's approval:

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. *THAT* a grant in the amount of \$1,000 be awarded to the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce in support of the Business and Arts Awards for 1996.

**R E P O R T**

An application was received from the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce requesting a grant in the amount of \$1,000 towards the Business and Art Awards partnership with the Burnaby Arts Council.

The awards recognize the contributions of organizations and individuals in the business community to the performing, visual and literary arts in Burnaby. Awards will be presented in four categories: Promotion of the Arts - awarded to a business which has promoted the arts through innovation, involvement and offering of time, goods or services; Financial Support - given to a business that has made a substantial financial commitment to the arts; Partnership - given to either a business or an arts group which has forged a long-term partnership between arts and business; Individual Leadership - acknowledges an individual who has demonstrated an extraordinary level of vision and dedication in their involvement with the arts.
