60-30-073 Upgrade Pump Stations Alarm System

Additional Information: This work order provides funding for improvements and expansion of the existing pump stations alarm system. The number of alarm points and data capture capability at each station will be enhanced with the upgraded hardware and software systems. It would also enable staff to remotely monitor system alarms and significantly improve the response time in the event of station malfunction. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sewer Utility component of the 1996 - 2000 Capital Program.
