REPORT

The Community Heritage Commission, at its meeting held on 1996 January 24 received an invitation to participate in a workshop entitled "Changing the Legislative Context for Heritage Conservation in British Columbia" on 1996 February 9th at Simon Fraser University, Harbour Centre in Vancouver.

This comprehensive one day workshop will assist in developing heritage conservation policies by learning how the current legislation affects municipalities. The workshop will address recent legislative changes incorporated into the Heritage Conservation Statutes Amendment Act and will explore specific case studies on topics such as heritage revitalization agreements, heritage area bylaws, heritage alteration permits and community heritage registers.

The registration fee for this workshop, sponsored by the Ministry of Small Business, Tourism and Culture is \$75.00 per person and funds are available in the Community Heritage Commission's budget.
