The Family Court and Youth Justice Committee, expressed an interest in attending the 1996 Family Court and Youth Justice Committee Provincial Conference in Victoria, B.C. from 1996 October 18 - 20. The total estimated cost for five (5) members to attend the subject conference is \$2,800.

The theme of the 1996 conference is "*The Work of a Family Court Committee.*" Conference highlights include a panel discussion regarding advocacy and review options for youth and families; presentations regarding criminalization of mental health issues, family maintenance enforcement issues and the new Young Offenders Act; and a workshop regarding the issue of being an effective Family Court and Youth Justice Committee.

Your Committee feels that the knowledge gained by attending this conference will be beneficial in terms of promoting awareness of issues facing Family Court & Youth Justice Committees.
