**REPORT**

At its meetings of 1993 March 29, Council adopted a notice of motion proposing the continuation of the Dedication of Parklands within Burnaby.

At its meeting of 1996 September 04, the Parks and Recreation Commission by motion approved the recommended wording of the 1996 Park Dedication Bylaw Question contained in the attached staff report in relation to Burnaby Mountain Conservation Area, Deer Lake Park, Byrne Creek Ravine Park, Taylor Park, Fourteenth Avenue Ravine Park, Ron McLean Park, Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park and Richmond Park, and so recommends to Council.

**SUBJECT: 1996 PARK DEDICATION BYLAW QUESTION**

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. THAT Council be requested to concur with the wording of the 1996 Park Dedication Bylaw question.

**REPORT**

At its meeting of 1993 March 29 Council adopted a notice of motion proposing the continuation of the Dedication of Parklands within Burnaby. The City Clerk in consultation with the City Solicitor and staff from the Planning and Building, Engineering and Parks and Recreation Departments have completed the majority of the required work for the 1996 Park Dedication Bylaw and have drafted the following Bylaw Question which will be posed at the upcoming local government election in November. The inclusion of Item 1 below presupposes Council's final approval of the land transfer agreement with Simon Fraser University.

(1) **BURNABY MOUNTAIN CONSERVATION AREA**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 371.29 hectares located in the northeast region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of BURNABY MOUNTAIN CONSERVATION AREA?

(2) **DEER LAKE PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 12.99 hectares located in the central region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of DEER LAKE PARK?

(3) **BYRNE CREEK RAVINE PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 21.07 hectares located in the southeast region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of BYRNE CREEK RAVINE PARK?

(4) **TAYLOR PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 8.10 hectares located in the southeast region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of TAYLOR PARK?

(5) **FOURTEENTH AVENUE RAVINE PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 2.80 hectares located in the southeast region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of FOURTEENTH AVENUE RAVINE PARK?

**(6) RON McLEAN PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 5.58 hectares located in the southeast region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of RON McLEAN PARK?

**(7) BURNABY FRASER FORESHORE PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 18.23 hectares located in south Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of BURNABY FRASER FORESHORE PARK?

**(8) RICHMOND PARK**

The proposed dedication is an area of approximately 4.86 hectares located in the east region of Burnaby.

Do you assent to the dedication of RICHMOND PARK?

As the Commission will note, the Bylaw Question has been designed to give the voter the freedom to express an opinion on each site to be dedicated. For each site the voter is asked "Do you assent to the dedication of (park name)?".

Staff request that the Commission approve the 1996 Bylaw Question and forward it to Council for concurrence.
