The Bicycle Advisory Committee, at its meeting held on 1997 January 30, received the attached plans (sketches #1,2 and 3) from the City of Vancouver for the proposed Midtown Bike Route/Greenway project.

The Committee noted that the proposed project connects to the City of Burnaby at two convenient locations on Boundary Road which can be linked in the future to Burnaby's network of cycling and pedestrian facilities. The Committee approved that a sub-committee review possible future connection in the area of Central Park and the BC Parkway.

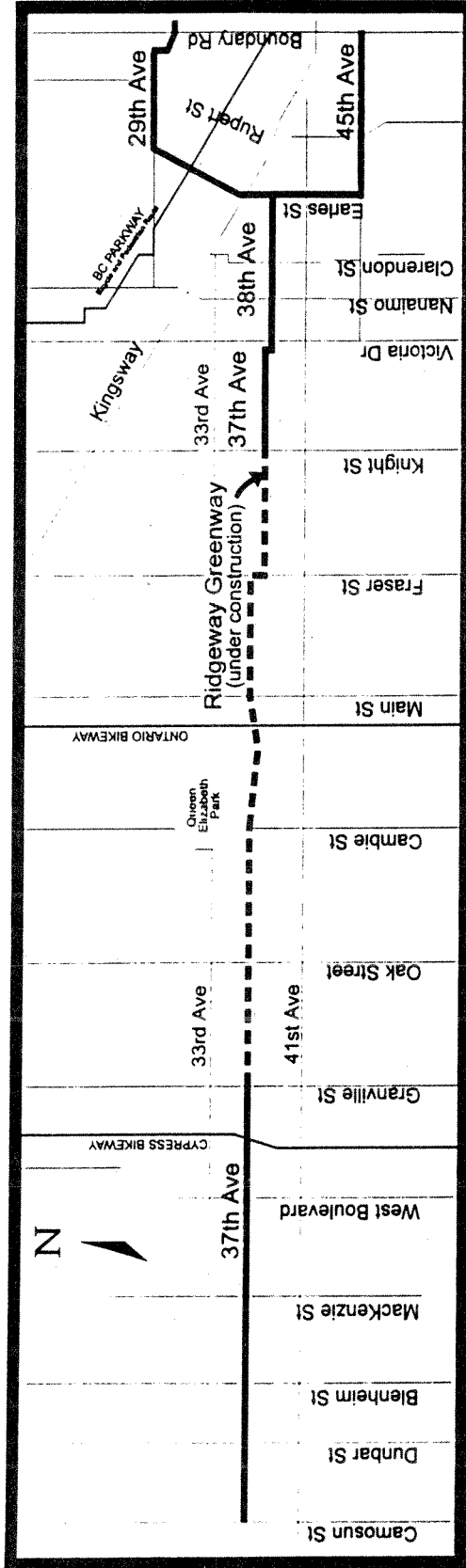
Consequently the Committee recommended that a letter be sent to the City of Vancouver in support of the proposed Midtown Bike Route/Greenway project.

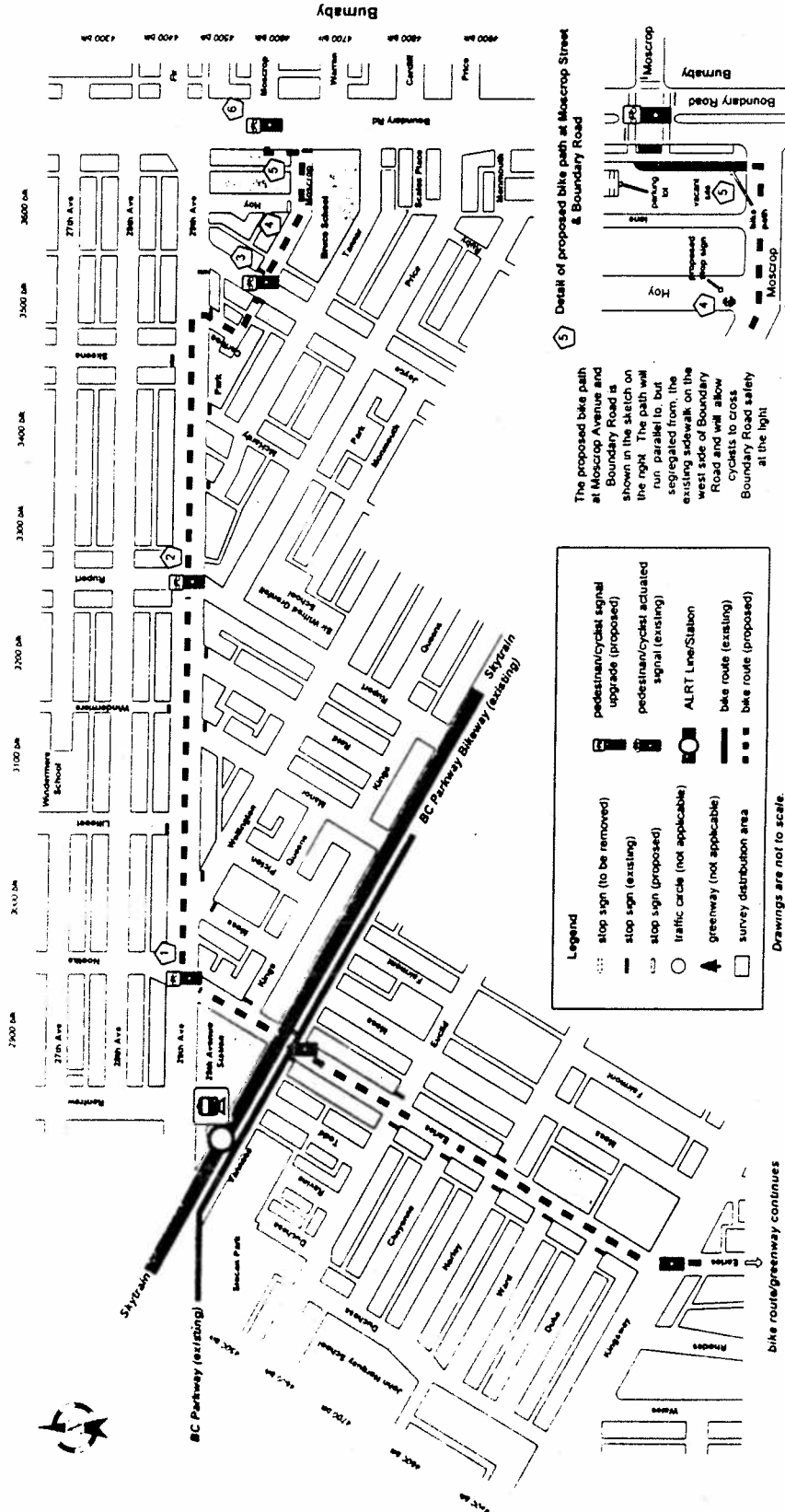
Proposed Bicycle Route along 37th, 38th, 29th, and 45th Avenues and Earles Street

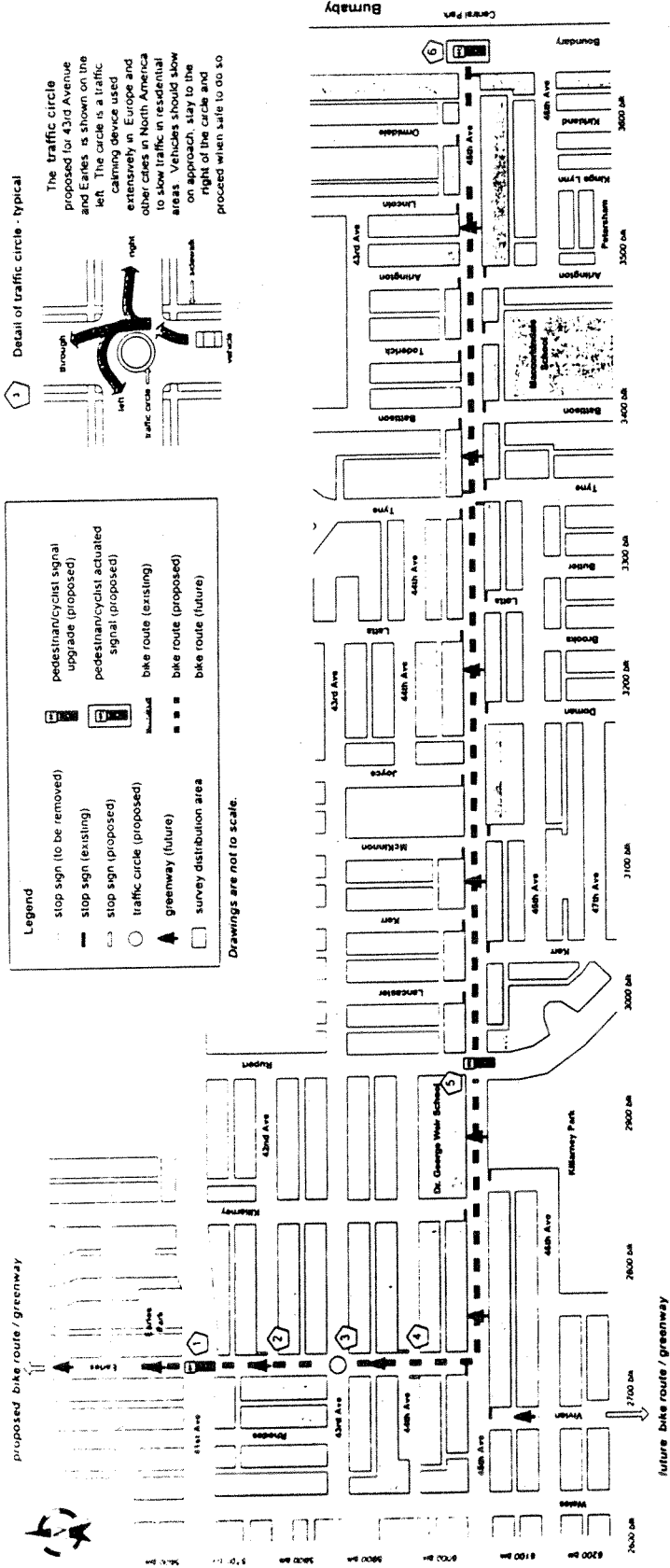
Midtown Bicycle Route - Earles, from Kingsway to 29th Ave; 29th Ave, from Earles to Boundary Road
