COMMITTEE - GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve the continuation of the Edmonds Area Advisory Committee.
2. THAT Council authorize staff to prepare terms of reference for the Committee which establish specific objectives.
3. THAT Council appoint four (4) new members to the Edmonds Area Advisory Committee.

REPORT

The Edmonds Area Advisory Committee, at its meeting held on 1997 February 13 held a lengthy discussion pertaining to the direction of the Committee and the role the Committee plays with respect to Council and the community.

It was the consensus of the Committee that consideration should be given to refocussing on issues and priorities within the Edmonds Town Centre Plan and that updated objectives be established through clearly defined terms of reference.

Further, due to a declining membership, the Committee requests Council to consider the appointment of four (4) additional Committee members (citizens at large) which would then provide a committee complement of 12 voting members.

The Committee considers it imperative to re-establish objectives at this time which will allow them to take a more active role in the ongoing implementation of the Edmonds Town Centre Plan.
