SUBJECT: CONTRACT NO. 9702  
TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES - VARIOUS LOCATIONS

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the supply and installation of traffic control devices.

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RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Imperial Electric Ltd., for the supply and installation of traffic control devices for a total cost of \$165,552.54 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Monday, 1997 April 14 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. A tabulation of the tenders received is attached (Attachment A).


The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the installation of traffic control devices at various locations within the City.

The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$172,000

The recommended bidder, Imperial Electric Ltd., has satisfactorily completed similar contracts for the City. Based on their past performance, the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract.

These expenditures are included under the 1997 Traffic Management component of the 1997-2001 Provisional Capital Program and the 1997 Provisional Operating Budget. Sufficient general revenue and capital reserve funding is available in existing work orders previously approved by Council.

The Director Engineering and our consultant, Shaflik Engineering Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.
