60-30-097 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation - Various Areas

Charge: 1997 Capital Budget

Additional Information: The 1997 Capital Program includes provision for rehabilitation of sanitary sewers at various locations. Rehabilitative measures include in-situ lining, grouting and point repairs to deteriorating sewer mains. An item recommending award of Contract 9717 that pertains to Phase I of the rehabilitation program appears elsewhere on Council's agenda. Phase I total estimated cost, including ancillary work by City forces, is \$150,000 and consists essentially of relining sewer mains using trenchless technology methods to repair a variety of defects that affect the structural integrity. Subsequent phases will be tendered later this year and would include grout sealing of cracks and joints to prevent groundwater from entering the sewer system. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sewer Utility component of the 1997 - 2001 Capital Program.
