PURPOSE:

To advise the Committee of the proposed modifications to the traffic signal at

Boundary Road and Hastings Street.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Burnaby cost share with the City of Vancouver for modifications to the traffic signal at Boundary Road / Hastings Street as outlined in this report.

REPORT

At the 1997 June 03 Traffic Safety Committee meeting, staff were directed to report back to the committee on the feasibility of installing left turn signalization at the intersection of Hastings St. / Boundary Rd. This improvement has been previously recommended but was omitted in the improvements made as part of the Barnet/Hastings People Moving Project. As this intersection is owned and maintained by the City of Vancouver, staff again reviewed the issue with representatives from Vancouver who indicated a willingness to proceed with the improvements.

In accordance with the cost share agreement with the City of Vancouver for the Boundary Road corridor, improvements at this intersection will be carried out by Vancouver, with a 50% share of actual costs assessed to Burnaby. Therefore we would recommend that improvements outlined the attached letter for the intersection of Boundary Road / Hastings Street be approved. Total cost of this project has been estimated at \$50,000, of which Burnaby's share would be \$25,000. Sufficient unallocated funds are available in the 1997 Traffic Management component of the Capital Budget.
