**SUBJECT: HIGH HAZARD FIREWORKS DISPLAY AT
KENSINGTON ARENA - 1997 DECEMBER 16 @ 19:00h**

PURPOSE: To seek Council authorization to approve the high hazard fireworks display in connection with the Kensington Arena Winter Wonderland at Kensington Sports Field on 1997 December 15 at 19:00h.

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RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the request to discharge high hazard fireworks be approved at the Kensington Arena Sports Field on 1997 December 15th at 18:45h.
2. THAT a copy of this report be forwarded to Mr. Gordon Chew 6896 Palm Avenue, Burnaby, B.C. V5J 4M3.

REPORT:

The use, set off or discharge of fireworks is permitted by Bylaw to take place in the period of October 25 through 31 each year. However, Section 933.1(a) of the Municipal Act permits Council to authorize the issuance of a permit to a person or organization for the purpose of the observance or celebration of a special event or festival by the use of fireworks of any kind and may specify terms and conditions.

Attached is a copy of a letter received from Ron Higo, Centre Supervisor Burnaby Parks & Recreation requesting permission to hold a high hazard fireworks display on 1997 December 15 from 18:45 - 19:00h. Also, attached is the:

- 1) Application to Purchase and the Permission of Local Authority
- 2) Site Map
- 3) A Certificate of Insurance for Five Million Dollars

The purpose of this report is to authorize, with Councils approval, the use of high level fireworks for this celebration with the following comments and conditions.

The Burnaby Fire Department has no objections to the subject display provided that:

1. Full compliance with the Burnaby Fire Department Fire Bylaw Part V, pertaining to fireworks.
2. This display complies with the Explosive Act of Canada
3. A site diagram is provided showing:
 - a) area where the high level fireworks will be set off.
 - b) area where the high level fireworks will be stored.
 - c) location of at least 2 - 5 lb. ABC dry chemical fire extinguishers at the display site
 - d) the fireworks supervisor must have a valid Fireworks Supervisor Card issued by Energy Mines & Resources Canada.
4. Western Canada Entertainment must provide proof of a minimum of Five (5) Million Dollars Liability Insurance, the City of Burnaby named as an additionally named insured for this event. The policy must include a Cross Liability Clause and a thirty (30) day written Notice of Cancellation Clause. In addition, a "copy" of this Liability Insurance is to be mailed to the Fire Prevention Division.

EXPLANATION OF SITE MAP AND FURTHER DETAILS FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY

KENSINGTON COMPLEX 1997 DECEMBER 15

6159 CURTIS STREET, BURNABY

1. The fireworks will be ignited in a northern direction with the ignition site located at the pitcher mound on the large baseball diamond. This uses the backstop as a barrier for protecting the spectators.

The baseball diamond will be closed by using snow fencing.

2. The storage for the fireworks will be located in four 50 gallon metal drums filled with sand and positioned on-site at homeplate, which is approximately 15 feet from the backstop. The fireworks will not arrive prior to the event so will require no storage before hand.

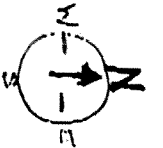
3. There will be two 5 pound A.B.C. dry powder extinguishers at the site located in close proximity to the metal drums.

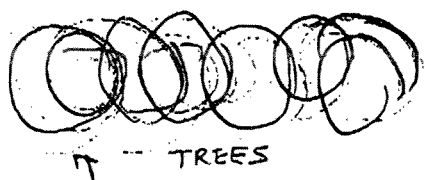
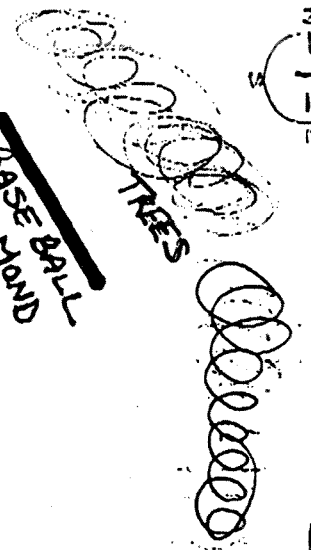
