RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$500 be awarded to the Burnaby Historical Society to assist with the cost of an event recognizing the 40th anniversary of the Society.

An application was received from Burnaby Historical Society requesting a grant to assist with the cost of an event to be held on 1997 June 25 which celebrates the 40th anniversary of the Society.

The event at Burnaby Village Museum includes a display in the Activity Room of the Carousel Pavilion, a dinner in the Ice Cream Parlour and a stage show by the Footlight Theatre Group. Mr. Chuck Davis, a free lance writer and historian, will be the guest speaker and Mayor Douglas P. Drummond and other V.I.P.'s will be invited.
