SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF BURNABY REPRESENTATIVE ON LRT STEERING COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Councillor Lee Rankin be appointed as Burnaby's representative on the LRT Steering Committee.

REPORT

The Mayor's office is in receipt of correspondence from the G.V.R.D. requesting Council to designate an appointee to serve on the LRT Steering Committee.

The Protocol Agreement for Light Rail Transit Development in Greater Vancouver designates the LRT Steering Committee to provide an administrative framework for the planning, preliminary design, engineering and public and stakeholder consultation needed for the development of light rail transit in the Broadway-Lougheed Highway - Coquitlam-New Westminster corridor.

The Steering Committee will be comprised of eleven members; four Provincial, one Transit Commission and six local government and will be co-chaired by the Province and local government.

It is anticipated that the Steering Committee mandate will be completed within 18 months of commencement, with a review in relation to progress on governance and funding in September, 1997.
