REPORT

The Traffic and Transportation Committee (Traffic Safety Division), at its meeting held on 1997 October 07, received two delegations with respect to on street parking on Still Creek Drive between Gilmore Avenue and Willingdon Avenue.

The first delegation from employees of the tenant of Slough Estates, submitted a letter and a petition in favour of allowing on street parking on Still Creek Drive.

The second presentation was received from Slough Estates expressing support for the status quo.

The Committee Chair advised the delegations that the parking regulations on the street had been approved by Council as a result of a recommendation by the Committee in 1993 and that without significant change in circumstances no further action was being proposed.

Arising from the discussion, the Committee requested that the correspondence from the delegations be referred to Council for information (provided under separate cover).
