SUBJECT: Burnaby Transportation Plan: Closure of Douglas Road at Lougheed Highway

PURPOSE: To respond to a question raised by Council with regard to the timing of the closure of Douglas Road south of Lougheed Highway.


RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Council receive this report for information.

REPORT

At its regular meeting of 1997 October 27, Council considered a report from the Director of Planning and Building with regards to the closure of Douglas Road south of Lougheed Highway identified in the Burnaby Transportation Plan. The report noted that this closure would not be effected until the supporting major road system in the Brentwood Town was in place with specific reference to Dawson Street between Boundary Road and Holdom.

Arising out of the discussion, Council queried whether the timing of the closure of Douglas south of Lougheed Highway also assumed that the Douglas/Holdom Connector as shown in Figure 1 would be open. In response, staff would confirm that the Douglas/Holdom Connector (at-grade crossing of the BNR) would need to be in place to accommodate the north/south travel displaced by the closure of Douglas Road as part of overall implementation of the Brentwood Town Centre transportation network.
