SUBJECT: 16TH AVENUE URBAN TRAIL

PURPOSE: To seek Council authority to bring down a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw for implementation of an urban trail on 16th Avenue.

RECOMMENDATION:


1. THAT a Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$100,000 be brought down to fund the implementation of the 16th Avenue urban trail.

R E P O R T

At the regular Council Meeting 1997 February 10, Council approved the implementation of an urban trail on 16th Avenue from Mary Avenue to 6th Street to be coordinated with implementation of an approved Local Improvement Project (LIP) at this location.

Construction of the LIP is planned to commence later this summer and will include final roadway standard, sidewalks, and street lighting. The urban trail project will include an asphalt bike path and associated urban trail landscaping and tree planting.

The urban trail component on 16th Avenue is estimated to cost \$100,000 and is not cost shared with local property owners under the LIP funding previously approved by Council. Therefore a Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw for \$100,000 (inclusive of 7% GST) is required to fund the implementation of the 16th Avenue urban trail from Mary Avenue to 6th Street. Sufficient Capital Reserves are available and the project is included under the 1997 Urban Trails component of the 1997-2001 Capital Program.
