**SUBJECT: PYROTECHNIC FIREWORKS DISPLAY AT
DEER LAKE PARK -1997 JULY 25**

PURPOSE: To seek Council's authorization to approve the Pyrotechnic Display in connection with the Burnaby Summer Games and the VSO at Deer Lake Park on 1997 July 25 at approx. 20:00h.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the request to discharge high-level fireworks at Deer Lake Park at 20:00h on 1997 July 25, be approved subject to full compliance with all the conditions as required by the City of Burnaby.
2. THAT a copy of this report be forwarded to Mr. Fireworks Attention: Mr. R. Greenwood - 3219 West 2nd Avenue, Vancouver, V6K 1K9 B.C.

REPORT:

The use, set off or discharge of fireworks in Burnaby is permitted by Bylaw to take place in the period of October 25 through 31 each year. However, Section 933(1) of the Municipal Act permits Council to authorize the issuance of a permit to a person or organization for the purpose of the observance or celebration of a special event or festival by the use of fireworks of any kind, and may specify terms and conditions.

Attached is a copy of a letter received from Mr. Fireworks (R. Greenwood & Associates) requesting permission to hold a high-level pyrotechnics display on 1997 July 25 at approx. 20:00h. Also, attached in the application is the:

- 1) Application to Purchase and the Permission of Local Authority
- 2) Site Map
- 3) A Certificate of Insurance for Five Million Dollars

The purpose of this report is to authorize, with Councils approval, the use of high-level fireworks for this celebration with the following comments and conditions.

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The Burnaby Fire Department has no objections to the subject display provided that:

1. Full compliance with the Burnaby Fire Department Fire Bylaw Part V, pertaining to fireworks
2. This display complies with the Explosive Act of Canada
3. A site diagram is provided showing:
 - a) area where the high-level fireworks will be set off.
 - b) area where the high-level fireworks will be stored.
 - c) location of at least 2 - 5 lb. ABC dry chemical fire extinguishers at the display site.
- 4) The fireworks supervisor must have a valid fireworks supervisor card issued by Energy Mines & Resources Canada.
- 5) The fireworks supervisor provide proof of a minimum of Two (2) Million Dollars Liability Insurance, with the City of Burnaby named as an additionally named Insured for this event. The policy must include a Cross Liability Clause and a thirty (30) day written Notice of Cancellation Clause. In addition, a "copy" of this Liability Insurance is to be mailed to the Fire Prevention Division.

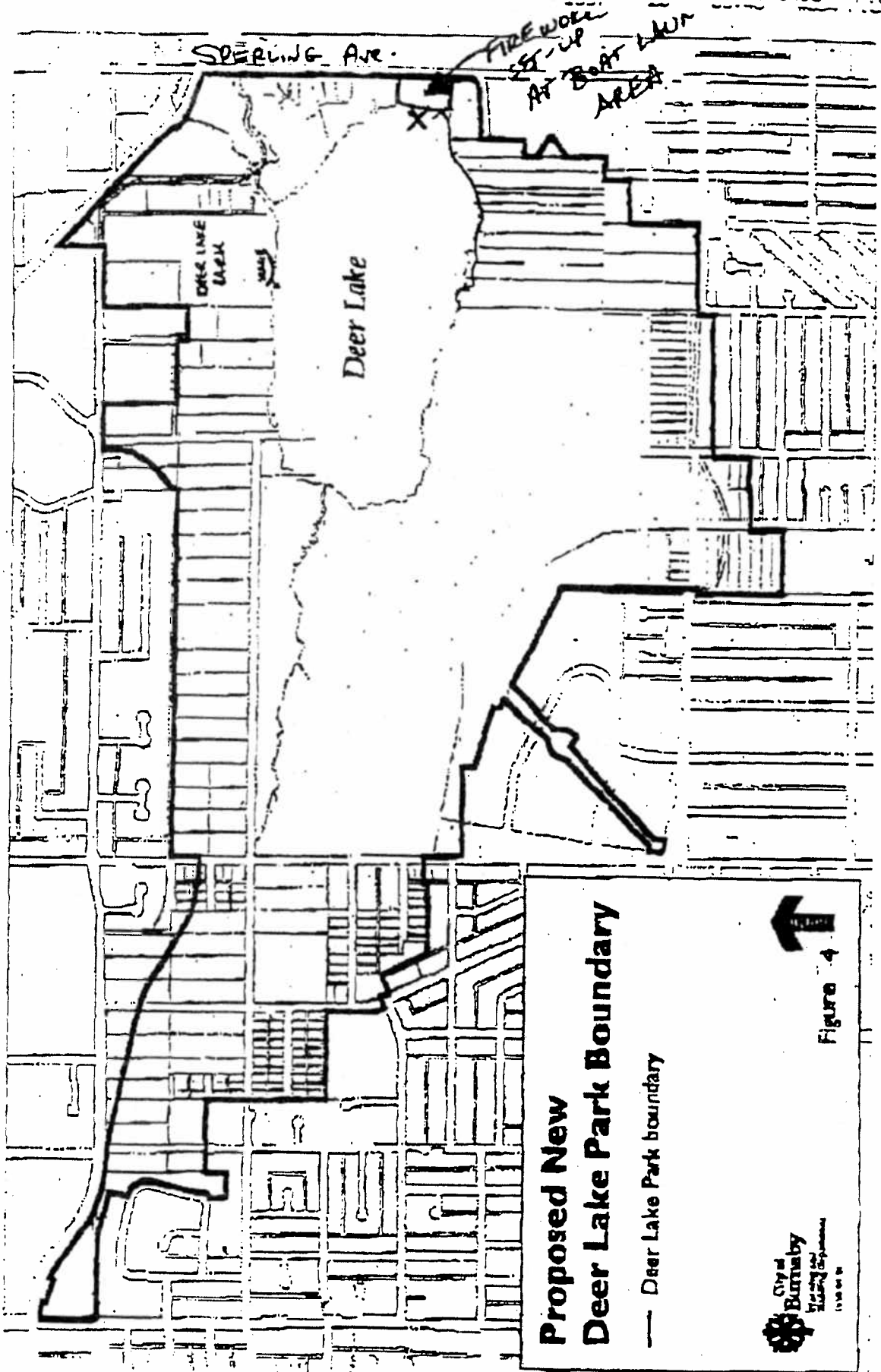
