RECOMMENDATION:

Crime Prevention Association National Training Symposium, 1998 September 23-26 at the Sheraton Guildford Hotel, Surrey, B.C.

REPORT

The Community Policing Committee, at its meeting held on 1998 June 11 received information pertaining to a National Training Symposium to be hosted by the B.C. Crime Prevention Association 1998 September 23-26. Workshops will be available to address the varied interests of those delegates attending the symposium.

In view of the Committee's activities involving Community Policing, the symposium presents an excellent opportunity to examine several topics in detail with experts in this field.

In order to permit Committee members to be reimbursed for their expenses, it is a requirement of the Municipal Act Section 267(b) that Committee representatives be recognized as delegates of Council for the purpose of attending the symposium. The estimated total cost for the delegates to attend the symposium is approximately \$1,575. Funds for the symposium have been provided in the Community Policing budget.
