2. THAT the City Solicitor be directed to prepare a license agreement with the Trustees for the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club.

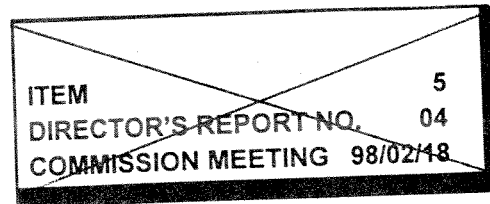
REPORT

SUBJECT: CENTRAL PARK HORSESHOE PITCHING CLUB LICENSE RENEWAL

RECOMMENDATIONS:

REPORT

The City has had an agreement with the Trustees of the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club for at least the last fifteen years. They continue to provide a valuable service to the community, and operate within the terms and conditions of their license.

The conditions of the license have been reviewed with members of the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club, and the following changes are proposed for the new five year term:

1. New trustees for the Central Park Horseshoe Pitching Club will be James Ball, President; Ed Ciriani and Sam Tomasevic.
2. Revised mailing address will be c/o 4229 Castlewood Crescent, Burnaby, B.C., V5G 2M1.
3. The new term for the license will be for five years commencing on the 15th day of April, 1998 and ending on the 14th day of April, 2003.
4. Insurance requirements for bodily injury liability and property damage liability will be each increased to \$2,000,000, complying with City standards.

It is recommended that approval be given for the renewal of the license agreement, as outlined in the report.
