PURPOSE:

To obtain Council approval of the 1998-2002 Capital Program

RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT the 1998-2002 Capital Program be received and approved and that the Burnaby Capital Expenditure Program Bylaw be amended.

REPORT

The 1998-2002 Capital Program is presented for adoption by Council. The 1998 Capital Budget is \$57,378,765. The Executive Summary section in the Budget provides the overview and highlights of the Capital Program.

STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS

Section 329 of the Municipal Act states:

- (1) "On or before May 15 in each year, a council must direct preparation of and adopt, by bylaw, a capital expenditure program for a period of at least 5 years, showing estimates of the proposed source and application of funds for capital purposes for each year of the program.
- (2) An adopted capital expenditure program, including amendments, remains in force until a new program is adopted in the following year."

In order to meet the statutory deadlines, the budget bylaw requires three readings by Council on May 04.
