RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT Council approve four (4) members of Advisory Planning Commission as delegates of Council for the purpose of attending the subject workshop.

REPORT

The Advisory Planning Commission at its meeting of 1998 April 23 received an invitation from Simon Fraser University to participate in a workshop entitled "Planning Design, and Development - An Overview for Municipal Advisory Commissions" to be held at Simon Fraser University at Harbour Centre in Vancouver on Thursday, 1998 May 14.

This one-day workshop will focus on the municipal design process and the role played by advisory commissions in the Lower Mainland. It will explore the mandate of municipal advisory commissions - design panels, advisory planning commissions, etc. and how they function within an environment of rapid growth and urban change. Speakers and panelists will include an architect, a city councillor, a municipal planner, an experienced member of an advisory planning commission, an urban design consultant and a lawyer.

The workshop is co-sponsored by the Simon Fraser University City Program and the Architectural Institute of British Columbia. The registration fee for the workshop is \$150 and funds are available in the 1998 Council Committee budget.
