REPORT


Section 630(1) of the Municipal Act states as follows:

630(1) - "A work for which notice is given in accordance with section 629 may be undertaken as a local improvement unless, within one month after the publication of the notice, a majority of the owners, representing at least 50% of the value of the parcels that are liable to be specially charged, petition the council **not to proceed** with it."

Petitions have been received **against** the following Local Improvement Projects as more particularly detailed in the attached schedule:

98 - 022

The foregoing petitions are hereby certified as sufficient as they represent a majority of owners who, in turn, represent at least 50% of the value of the parcels liable to be specially charged. Council is, therefore, **precluded** from proceeding with these projects.
