The Executive Committee of Council submits the following recommendations for Council's approval:

**#30/99      Planned Parenthood Association of B.C.**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$500 be awarded to Planned Parenthood Association of B.C. to assist with the purchase of a VCR player and monitor for the Burnaby Clinic.

**R E P O R T**

Planned Parenthood B.C. is a charitable non-profit organization with clinics throughout the province. The organization's mission is to reduce unplanned pregnancies and promote optimal reproductive health by providing quality education, information and clinical services.

The Burnaby Clinic has provided services to the community for 29 years and is presently located on the BCIT campus. It is open to everyone in the community and is staffed by three physicians, a RN supervisor and eight dedicated volunteers.

Sexual health education is essential for the prevention of unplanned pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases. Therefore, one of the main components of the health program for all clinic patients is the viewing of educational videos. These videos cover many topics, including contraception options, pregnancy, healthy decision making and sexually transmitted disease prevention.

**R E P O R T**

An application was received requesting financial assistance for the 1999 Christmas Campaign. The Burnaby Christmas Bureau provides low income Burnaby families with food gift certificates and Christmas toys. In 1998, the Bureau distributed \$112,025 in food gift certificates which provided 4,913 people with a Christmas meal. In addition, 8,538 new toys were provided for children.
