REPORT

The Civic Development Committee, at its meeting held on 1999 March 25, received and adopted the *attached* report providing a progress update on the Hastings-Brentwood Community Police Station. The Committee advised that Council, at its meeting held on 1999 March 08, authorized execution of a five year lease for approximately 2,570 sq. ft. of space at 4191 Hastings Street. The Committee further advised that the lease offer proposed by the landlord includes a majority of the tenant improvements being undertaken by the property owner at his expense. The Committee concluded by advising that the City will be responsible for minimal premises - related capital expenses, as well as furnishings and equipment for the station.
