The Executive Committee of Council submits the following recommendations for Council's approval:

**#51/99 Wildlife Rescue Association of B.C.**

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$5,000 be awarded to the Wildlife Rescue Association of B.C. for the year 1999.

REPORT

An application was received requesting funds to support ongoing services to the City and residents of Burnaby.

The Wildlife Rescue Association of B.C. is now entering its 20th year of operation. The purpose of the organization is to reduce and prevent suffering of injured, orphaned and pollution damaged wildlife through rehabilitation and education. The number of animals treated ranges between 3200 and 3600 per year and will likely remain at this level as urban encroachment continues to take its toll on wildlife.
