SUBJECT: CONTRACT NO. 9928 - LINING OF SANITARY AND STORM SEWERS - VARIOUS LOCATIONS
PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the lining of sewers.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Insituform Technologies Ltd., for lining sewers at various locations for a total cost of \$274,629.41 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Two tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, 1999 August 31 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Insituform Technologies Ltd.	\$274,629.41
Planned & Engineering Construction, Inc.	\$321,317.79

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the lining of approximately 950 meters of various sized sewers using trenchless technology methods.

The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$285,000.00

The recommended bidder, Insituform Technologies Ltd., has satisfactorily completed similar work for the City. Based on their past performance, the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract.

Sufficient General Revenue Utility Funds are available and this project is included under the 1999 Sewer Utility Component of the 1999-2003 Capital Program. A Work Order report appears elsewhere on the agenda.

The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.
