**60-21-130 Watermain Replacements (1999 Program - Phase I)**

**Charge:** 1999 Capital Budget  
 Watermains, pumping stations, etc. \$800,000

**Additional Information:** Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is an item recommending award of Contract #9904, Watermain Replacements (1999 Program - Phase I). The program consists essentially of replacing watermains with a history of frequent breaks and high maintenance costs. Total cost of Phase I, including additional work by City forces, is estimated at \$800,000. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Water Utility component of the 1999 - 2003 Capital Program.

**60-32-108 Miscellaneous Storm Drainage Improvements - Various Locations**

**Charge:** 1999 Capital Budget  
 Storm Extensions \$75,000

**Additional Information:** A work order is raised annually to provide funding for the ongoing program of storm drainage improvements, including ditch elimination and catch basin installations, to improve drainage and reduce potential for flooding at various locations. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Storm Extension component of the 1999 - 2003 Capital Program.
