SUBJECT: REZONING REFERENCE 98-9 - NORTHEAST SCHOOL COST SHARING FOR BEAVERBROOK/EASTLAKE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES

PURPOSE: To Request Council Approval of Funding for the City's Share of the Servicing Costs Related to the above Project.


RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** staff be authorized to proceed with Capital Works in the amount of \$181,000 for the completion of pedestrian improvements and the City's share of the traffic signalization costs at the intersection of Beaverbrook Drive and Eastlake Drive.

R E P O R T

The development of the Northeast Burnaby Secondary School is proceeding. Part of the servicing requirements included the provision of pedestrian improvements and a share of the costs of signalization of the intersection of Eastlake Drive and Beaverbrook Drive to be funded by the City. The estimate for the City's contribution to these works is \$181,000 inclusive of inspection fees and GST. A portion of the works to be cost shared was approved by Council on 1998 October 19 and the balance was approved by Council on 1998 October 26.

Sufficient Land Assembly Funds are available to finance this project, which is included under the 1999 Land Assembly General Development component of 1999-2003 Capital Program. Capital works will commence this Fall. The opening of the new Northeast school is scheduled for the Fall of 2000.
