A letter dated 1999 May 07 was received from Mr. R.D. Ingram, Secretary Treasurer, School District No. 41 - Burnaby advising that during the 1998/99 school year, 24 elementary schools in the district operated school patrols which involved a total of 1200 students. In recognition of the voluntary commitment displayed by the student crossing guards, the City of Burnaby has, for several years, forwarded funds to the schools on the basis of the number of participating pupils, to assist in the costs of an event thanking the students.
