**SUBJECT:** GRANDVIEW HIGHWAY EAST UPGRADING/WILLINGDON AVENUE FREEWAY ON-RAMP

**PURPOSE:** To seek Council approval to bring down a Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$555,000 for road improvements and infrastructure renewals on Grandview Highway and Willingdon Avenue freeway on-ramp

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT Council bring down a Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$555,000 for road improvements and infrastructure renewals on Grandview Highway and Willingdon Avenue freeway on-ramp

**REPORT**

Council, at its regular meeting of 1997 November 17, approved cost sharing with the Provincial Government on the upgrading of Grandview Highway and the construction of a relocated Willingdon Avenue freeway on-ramp. Road improvements and, water and sewer infrastructure renewals were completed with the Freeway High Occupancy Vehicle Project. The City's share of final costs is \$555,000, inclusive of 7% GST. It is recommended that a Capital Reserve Expenditure Bylaw be brought down in this amount to finance the City's portion. Sufficient Capital Reserves are available and these expenditures are included under the Major Roads component of the 1999 - 2003 Capital Program.
