**RECOMMENDATION**

1. THAT Council authorize up to three (3) members of the Community Heritage Commission to attend the 1999 Annual Conference of the Heritage Society of B.C. and that all costs associated with attendance of the Conference be paid by the City.

**REPORT**

The Community Heritage Commission, at its meeting on 1999 May 13 expressed an interest in attending the subject Conference which is to be held in Prince George from 1999 June 24 to 27.

The theme of this year's Conference is "Heritage-scapes" -- which is defined as: "History inscribed in the land, in memories, in built environment, in people's hearts." Keynote speaker for the Conference is Dr. Jan Penney, head of Interpretation and Research for Sovereign Hill in Ballarat, Australia -- a leading world heritage destination site.

The cost for three members of the Commission to attend the Conference is estimated to be \$4,500.
