SUBJECT: HASTINGS-BRENTWOOD COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICE

PURPOSE: To provide the Civic Development Committee with a progress update on the Hastings-Brentwood Community Police Office.

Recommendation:


1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1999 March 08, Council authorized staff to execute a five year lease, commencing 1999 May 01, for approximately 2,570 square feet of space at 4191 Hastings Street, for the establishment of a Community Police Station. The lease offer proposed by the landlord included a majority of the tenant improvements being undertaken by the property owner at his expense.

The contractor (retained by the property owner), commenced the tenant improvements in June of 1999. A minor portion of the renovation work was undertaken by the City and was completed on budget. Substantial completion was declared on 1999 August 16, with the RCMP moving into the space shortly thereafter.

The official opening of the Community Police Office took place on Saturday, 1999 September 18 and is now open to the public.
