2000 PROVISIONAL OPERATING BUDGET

**PURPOSE:** 

To approve the 2000 Provisional Operating Budget.

## RECOMMENDATION

1. **THAT** the 2000 Provisional Operating Budget be received and adopted, and that a provisional budget bylaw which appears on this agenda be brought forward.

## REPORT

Copies of the 2000 Provisional Operating Budget for members of Council are enclosed with their agendas.

This budget reflects a net tax draw increase of 2.39%. This is after new tax revenue from building construction throughout the city during the past year, estimated at \$1,600,000. The allocation between property classes is determined in May each year.

It is a requirement of the Municipal Act (Interim Provisional Budgeting Regulation - B.C. REG308/99) that Council adopt the Provisional Budget before 1999 December 31.

Adoption of this budget does not commit Council to a decision as to the amount of taxation nor the distribution thereof. These decisions must be made before a Financial Plan is adopted on or before 2000 May 15.
