
PURPOSE: To seek Council approval to bring down a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw for \$100,000 to interim finance a review of alternative methods for the rehabilitation of Gaglardi Way, north from the Cariboo Road overpass.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize bringing down a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw for \$100,000 to interim finance a review of alternative methods for the rehabilitation of Gaglardi Way, north from the Cariboo Road overpass.

REPORT

Responsibility for the maintenance, pavement rehabilitation and traffic management on Gaglardi Way, north from the Cariboo Road overpass, was transferred to the City with formation of the GVTA (subsequently TransLink). Included in the declassification initiative was the commitment by the GVTA to finance the rehabilitation of downloaded roads where pavement condition, at the time of transfer, was substantially below the regional network average. Pavement condition on Gaglardi Way is below the regional network average. Consultancy services to review alternative methods and costs for pavement rehabilitation are required. The total cost for the review is estimated at \$100,000. Sufficient Capital Reserves are available to interim finance this project and these expenditures are included under the Major Roads component of the 2000 - 2004 Annual Capital Program. On completion, TransLink will be invoiced for the total project costs and the funds will be returned to Capital Reserves.
