PURPOSE:

To inform Council of responses to issues raised at the 2000 November 28 Public

Hearing for the subject rezoning.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

At the 2000 November 28 Public Hearing for Rezoning Reference #00-17, a high technology office building, concerns were raised about the height of the rear of the building and the status of the trail at the edge of the site.

With regard to the four storey height of the building, the guideline for the site requires a two storey height above existing grade measured from the lower boundary of the landscape buffer at the perimeter of the site facing Huxley Avenue. By depressing the lower two storeys into the significant downward slope of the ground and extending the rear yard setback facing Huxley Avenue, the number of storeys is appropriately handled and is technically in compliance with the guidelines.

With regard to the status of the ad hoc trail on the perimeter of the site in the future conservation area, it is to remain in place and not be further developed. The Discovery Place Community Plan indicated that additional unobtrusive trails would be built only on sites K, C and M (see <u>attached</u> Sketch #1).


