SUBJECT: **CONTRACT NO. 2000-13 - BURNABY ROADWORKS RECONSTRUCTION AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS**

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for watermain construction and road widening and reconstruction.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, J. Cote & Son Excavating Ltd., for construction of watermain and for road widening and reconstruction, for a total cost of \$1,091,609.10 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Six tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Thursday, 2000 May 4 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The six tenders received are as follows:

J. Cote & Son Excavating Ltd.	\$1,091,609.10
Gemco Construction Ltd.	\$1,117,719.59
Jack Cewe Ltd.	\$1,163,671.01
Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$1,276,113.03
C.A.P. Ventures Ltd.	\$1,277,416.80
Winvan Paving Ltd.	\$1,354,466.99

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the installation of approximately 765 metres of various diameter watermain, and for 1,035 metres of road reconstruction and widening at three locations. The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$1,205,000.

The recommended bidder, J. Cote & Son Excavating Ltd., has satisfactorily completed similar contracts for the City. Based on their past performance, the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.

Funding for this project is available in existing work orders 60-40-246 and 60-16-180 which have previously been approved by Council.
