Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is an item recommending the award of Contract 2000-06: Supply and Installation of Machine Laid Asphaltic Concrete. This work order provides partial funding for this contract. The balance of funding is provided within existing work orders previously approved by Council. The contract constitutes the City's annual pavement rehabilitation program which consists essentially of removing deteriorated pavement surface and replacement with a new asphaltic overlay. It is an integral component of our infrastructure renewal strategy that protects the City's significant investment in the road system by extending the useful life of pavement. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Street and Lane Rehabilitation component of the 2000 - 2004 Provisional Capital Program.
