60-32 -115 Slope Stabilization - John Mathews Ravine

Charge: 2000 Provisional Capital Budget
Storm Drainage Extensions \$175,000

Additional Information: High rainfalls late last year induced a soil erosion slope failure in the John Mathews ravine. Immediate rehabilitative measures are required to stabilize the ravine to prevent further failures. Total estimated project cost is \$175,000. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available, however, these expenditures are not included in the 2000 Provisional Capital Budget. It is recommended that remedial work be undertaken immediately and that the approved provisional capital spending limit be increased accordingly.
