RE: CAN BIKE PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Council authorize up to (3) three members of the Bicycle Advisory Committee and (1) one City staff to attend the CanBike program at an approximate cost of \$400.

REPORT

The Bicycle Advisory Committee, at its meeting held on 2000 May 25, received information regarding CanBike Cycling Skills courses. The available dates for registration for the upcoming CanBike course is July 08 (Saturday - 6 hours), July 12 (Wednesday P.M. - 3 hours) and July 15 (Saturday - 6 hours). The course will be held at Burnaby City Hall. The costs for the course will be \$100 per person.

The CanBike cycling courses are designed to equip adults with the skills and knowledge to handle themselves and traffic safely. CanBike is recognized, across Canada, as a prerequisite for bicycle professionals such as police/security personnel. Members of the Bicycle Advisory Committee are invited to attend and registration is also extended to city staff whose work includes cycle infrastructure planning, and/or who have a keen interest in commuter cycling.

The cost for approximately 3 members and 1 staff to attend the CanBike program will be charged to the Operating Contingency.
