REPORT

Mrs. Kathleen Turner of 4136 Hazelwood Crescent and Mrs. Shirley Taylor of 4167 Hazelwood Crescent, who live on opposite sides of the same street have submitted a letter and petition requesting the installation of lights in the lanes behind their residences. A petition with signatures of 2/3 of the affected properties must be submitted to the Engineering Department before the request can be forwarded to the Committee for approval and subsequently B.C. Hydro. This requirement has been met.

On the basis of policy based on the length of lane staff initially proposed one light per lane.

As indicated in the attached correspondence both of the lead petitioners requested an additional light. As a result staff reviewed the proposed lighting arrangements and concur with the additional requirements of curvature. We note that the shorter lane behind the rear of 4136 Hazelwood falls short of the requirement for a second light by only 17 metres.

We recommend that the Committee endorse the installation of 2 lights in each lane as indicated on the attached plans.


