More than 200 non-profit agencies and groups list detailed volunteer positions on Volunteer Burnaby's computer database. At any given time there are more than one thousand different volunteer opportunities available.

Volunteer Burnaby's objective for this year is to continue as a Centre of Excellence in Volunteerism and to identify new and improved ways of serving the community. The organization's goals include developing an on-line community information portal on volunteerism and volunteering, expanding the Special Needs Access Program in partnership with the Ministry of Children & Families to support individuals with learning disabilities and continuing participation in volunteer recruitment fairs with Burnaby educational and community institutions.
