RE: SKYTRAIN BIKE PATH (BC PARKWAY)

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Council request TransLink to investigate hazardous elements on the BC Parkway and to address other deficiencies noted in the BC Parkway Improvement Committee's report.

R E P O R T

At the 2000 September 25 Open Council meeting, Council received correspondence from Mr. Glen Smith advising of a hazardous situation for cyclists on the SkyTrain bike path (BC Parkway) within the vicinity of Rumble Street.

Council resolved to refer the letter to the Bicycle Advisory Committee for consideration. Council also at that time, noted that the "missing" bollard referred to by Mr. Smith is only two (2) inches high and therefore requested that staff place something larger in that location which is coated in fluorescent paint until such time as TransLink completes the repairs.

Arising from review of the correspondence, your Committee at its meeting held on 2000 September 28, has requested that Council write to TransLink requesting that they investigate hazardous elements on the BC Parkway and address other deficiencies as noted in the BC Parkway Improvement Committee's report (AVAILABLE IN CLERK'S OFFICE).

The Committee requests Council support of the recommendations as part of Burnaby's response to the cyclist's concerns.
