**SUBJECT: CONTRACT NO. 2000-20 - BYRNE CREEK FLOOD MITIGATION**

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for Byrne Creek rehabilitation and related works.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Mission Contractors Ltd., for Byrne Creek rehabilitation between Byrne Road and Marine Way for a total cost of \$310,049.06 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered. The award will be subject to the receipt of project approval by the Ministry of Environment, Lands and Parks as well as the Department of Fisheries and Oceans.

**REPORT**

Two tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Thursday, July 13, 2000 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Mission Contractors Ltd.	\$310,049.06
Roberds Excavating (1991) Ltd.	\$384,010.76

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the excavation of the existing channel, fish habitat enhancements, stream complexing and other related works. The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$285,000.

The recommended bidder, Mission Contractors Ltd., has satisfactorily completed numerous contracts for the City. Based on their past performance, the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract.

Sufficient funds are available and this project is included under the Storm Drainage component of the 2000-2004 Capital Program. Appearing elsewhere on the agenda is a work order report seeking funding approval for this project. The Director Engineering and our consultant, Associated Engineering (B.C.) Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.
