

**Charge:** 2000 Annual Capital Budget  
Sanitary Extensions \$180,000

**Additional Information:** The sewer system network contains several sewage pump stations and force mains of various ages. As part of the infrastructure management program, partial or complete replacements of pumps and other ancillary equipment is required at times to ensure service delivery. This work order provides funding for periodic system evaluation, replacement and upgrading of miscellaneous equipment at various locations. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sanitary Sewer component of the 2000 - 2004 Capital Program.
