

**60-30-109 Combined Area Sewer Separation - Engineering Services (2002 Program)**

**Charge:** 2002 Provisional Capital Budget  
Sanitary Extensions \$250,000

**Additional Information:** Burnaby is committed under the GVRD's Liquid Waste Management Plan to undertake a combined sewer separation program aimed at eliminating combined sewer overflows. The 2002 Draft Provisional Capital Budget includes \$3.80 million to continue this program. Consultancy services are required to prepare detailed engineering designs over the winter period in anticipation of tender calls early next year. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sanitary Sewer component of the 2002 - 2006 Draft Provisional Capital Program.
