REPORT


A request to use a City street for a Canada Day Celebration on 2001 July 01 has been received from Louise Rusch of the City of Burnaby's Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The City of Burnaby Parks & Recreation Department is organizing a community festival celebrating Canada Day on Sunday, 2001 July 01 between 11:00 am and 2:30 pm. The Festival would require the closure of Vista Crescent from Humphries to Fulton during the event.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the event be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.

As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.
