Westridge Combined Area Sewer Separation (2001 Program - Phase I)

Additional Information: Sewers in the general north Burnaby area convey both sanitary and stormwater flows in a single pipe. During wet weather combined sewer overflows can occur. Burnaby is committed under the GVRD's Liquid Waste Management Plan to undertake a combined sewer separation program to eliminate combined sewer overflows. Protection of public health and the environment are the primary benefit of the separation program. A comprehensive program to replace existing combined sewers with separate sanitary and storm sewers commenced last year in the Westridge area.

Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is an item recommending the award of Contract 2001-15: Westridge Combined Area Sewer Separation Program. This contract continues the separation program in the Westridge area. Total cost of this phase, including ancillary work by city forces, is estimated at \$1.4 Million. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sanitary Sewer component of the 2001 - 2005 Capital Program.
