**PURPOSE:** To seek Council approval for slope stabilization work on Penzance Drive.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** Council authorize bringing down a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw for \$100,000 to finance engineering services related to slope stabilization works on Penzance Drive.

**REPORT**

In 1997, the City completed emergency slope stabilization work on Penzance Drive in the vicinity of Chevron refinery. At that time, the City also entered an agreement with Chevron to jointly fund a feasibility study to evaluate alternative methods that would bring about a more permanent solution to potential slope failures along Penzance Drive. This study has now been completed and consultancy services are required to undertake detailed engineering designs and contract administration. Total cost of this assignment is estimated at \$100,000 and these expenditures are included under the Special Roads component of the 2002 - 2006 Provisional Capital Program. On completion, Chevron will be invoiced for 50% of total project costs.

Construction of the stabilization work is planned for 2003.
