Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is an item recommending the award of Contract 2002-17: Westridge Combined Area Sewer Separation (2002 Program - Phase I). This contract is a continuation of the City's overall program to replace existing combined sewers in the Westridge area with separate sanitary and storm sewers. It conforms with the Greater Vancouver Regional District's (GVRD) Liquid Waste Management Plan to eliminate combined sewer overflows. Total project cost is estimated at \$920,000. This work order provides partial funding for Phase II contract; additional funding requirements are available in an existing work order previously approved by Council. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sanitary Sewer component of the 2002 - 2006 Capital Program.
